Students should anticipate their academic workload to be as follows: 1-2 credits = at least 5-11 study hours a week
3-6 credits = at least 14-33 study hours a week
7-10 credits = at least 32-55 hours a week

Students may petition the university to take a one term academic hiatus (AH) or emergency academic hiatus (EAH); but are limited to a total of two academic hiatus terms every 365 days.
