The FNU Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) specialty track educates students for advanced practice to manage the healthcare of individuals and their families by providing preventive and primary care, promoting health and wellbeing, and helping their patients manage chronic conditions. FNP's conduct routine checkups and assessments, order, and interpret tests, make diagnoses, prescribe medications, and initiate and manage treatment plans for their patients.

Admissions and Tuition

- Rolling admissions with four deadlines each year.
- Students will complete coursework online with two visits to campus and a clinical practicum in their home community.
- With assistance from FNU, students identify clinical sites in their own communities.
- Must have a 3.0 GPA in their last degree earned.‡
- One year of RN experience required before applying to the MSN program.
- We offer affordable tuition rates, financial aid, and a number of scholarships.
- Tuition for MSN and PGC program is \$705 per credit hour.*

‡Applicants who have a GPA of 2.80-2.99 from the most recent degree earned in nursing or a related field are required to provide a statement supporting their application.

Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Program

- An excellent option for an RN with a bachelor's degree.
- 52 credit hours; full-time and part-time options available.

Post-Graduate Certificate (PGC) Program

- An excellent option for nurses with a master's or higher degree in nursing and a national certification in advanced practice as a nurse-midwife or nurse practitioner. (Check Frontier.edu for the specialties.)
- 39 credit hours; 18 month program
