The Psychiatric-Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) specialty track educates students for advanced practice to improve mental health care and the overall health status of communities. With a focus on lifetime care for individuals, PMHNPs are committed to promoting mental health through assessment, diagnosis and treatment of behavioral problems, mental disorders and comorbid conditions. FNU PMHNP students are educated to exemplify the caring behaviors we hope to bring to the wide healthcare system with a focus on diverse, rural and underserved communities.

Admissions and Tuition

- Rolling admissions with four deadlines each year.
- Students will complete coursework online with two visits to campus and a clinical practicum in their home community.
- With assistance from FNU, students identify clinical sites in their own communities.
- Must have a 3.0 GPA in their last degree earned.‡
- One year of RN experience required before applying to the MSN program.
- We offer affordable tuition rates, financial aid, and a number of scholarships.
- Tuition for MSN and PGC program is \$755 per credit hour.*

‡Applicants who have a GPA of 2.80-2.99 from the most recent degree earned in nursing or a related field are required to provide a statement supporting their application.

Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Program

- An excellent option for an RN with a bachelor's degree.
- 48 credit hours; full-time and part-time options available.

Post-Graduate Certificate (PGC) Program

- An excellent option for nurses with a master's or higher degree in nursing and a national certification in advanced practice as a nurse-midwife or nurse practitioner. (Check Frontier.edu for the specialties.)
- 35 credit hours; 18 months
