A Women's Health Care Nurse Practitioner (WHNP) is an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) that specializes in providing holistic, client-centered primary health care for women throughout their lives. WHNPs focus on well-women care, reproductive, common and complex gynecological care, prenatal and postpartum care, menopause-transition, and post-menopause; healthcare and sexual and reproductive health care for men. WHNPs also focus on health promotion, disease prevention, health education, and helping individuals make smart lifestyle choice.

Admissions and Tuition

- Rolling admissions with four deadlines each year.
- Students will complete coursework online with two visits to campus and a clinical practicum in their home community.
- With assistance from FNU, students identify clinical sites in their own communities.
- Must have a 3.0 GPA in their last degree earned.‡
- One year of RN experience required before applying to the MSN program.
- We offer affordable tuition rates, financial aid, and a number of scholarships.
- Tuition for MSN and PGC program is \$705 per credit hour.*

‡Applicants who have a GPA of 2.80-2.99 from the most recent degree earned in nursing or a related field are required to provide a statement supporting their application.

Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Program

- An excellent option for an RN with a bachelor's degree.
- 49 credit hours; full-time and part-time options available.

Post-Graduate Certificate (PGC) Program

- An excellent option for nurses with a master's or higher degree in nursing and a national certification in advanced practice as a nurse-midwife or nurse practitioner. (Check Frontier.edu for the specialties.)
- 36 credit hours; 18 months
