PROGRAM OPTIONS

Master of Science in Nursing (MSN)

- An excellent option for an RN with a bachelor's degree
- 55 credit hours; full-time and part-time options available

Post-Graduate Certificate (PGC)

- An excellent option for nurses with a master's or higher degree in nursing and a national certification in advanced practice as a nurse-midwife or nurse practitioner

- 42 credit hours; 21 months



ADMISSIONS AND TUITION

- Rolling admissions with four deadlines each year
- Online coursework with two campus visits and a clinical practicum in the student's home community
- Assistance in identifying clinical sites within the student's local community
- Minimum 3.0 GPA in the most recent degree earned‡
- One year of RN experience required prior to MSN application
- Affordable tuition rates, financial aid, and scholarship opportunities available
- Tuition rate: \$705 per credit hour*

‡Applicants who have a GPA of 2.80-2.99 from the most recent degree earned in nursing or a related field are required to provide a statement supporting their application.
